Public hearing for inquiry into circumvention of anti-dumping laws

The House of Representatives Agriculture and Industry Committee will conduct a public hearing tomorrow, Thursday, 26 February 2015, for the inquiry into circumvention of anti-dumping laws.

Appearing at this second hearing for the inquiry will be two companies involved in recent anti-dumping cases, Capral Ltd and ABB Australia.

Committee Chair, Rowan Ramsey MP, said "The Committee is keen to hear from Capral, a company that has suffered injury because of product dumping. We are also keen to hear from ABB Australia which has recently been the subject of an anti-dumping investigation concerning power transformers. Both companies should be able to help us understand anti-dumping issues and the handling of investigations".
