2017 ATO Annual Report—Performance Review Technical and behavioural approaches

The House Tax and Revenue Committee will this week hear from the Australian Tax Commissioner and the Inspector-General of Taxation in its review of the performance of the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) over 2016–17. The meeting will start with evidence from the Inspector-General of Taxation.

The Committee will follow-up a variety of matters with the Inspector-General of Taxation as raised in his submission to the inquiry and explore progress in areas of recommendation in the Committee's report of the review of the 2015-16 Annual Report.

The Committee will take evidence from the Tax Commissioner and ATO officials about the measures being deployed to improve willing compliance across the whole community—from small to very large business, and individuals, while the Inspector-General of Taxation and his Deputy will be invited to discuss the fairness and efficiencies of the ATO's debt collection processes, and related matters.
