I would like to state that the consent of the adoption of my child was given without information of my legal rights.

I gave birth to a son at Crow St Women's hospital on the (...) 1963.

- ① I was not allowed to see my son after birth.
- ② I was not given information in regard to foster care for my child.
- ③ I was not informed of any life long future regrets if I surrendered my child for adoption.
- ④ I was not given information or financial assistance that would enable me to keep my son.
