Air Services Amendment Bill 2018

The incoming number of air flights over East Melbourne has become most notable and intrusive, consequently causing safety concerns.

In raising these concerns, I have been informed that flight paths have been de-regulated …. which surely is a serious safety risk. Especially in the vicinity of the Melbourne Cricket Ground and Melbourne's central business district.
