



Public hearing into proposed fit-out for AFP in Queensland

The Public Works Committee is conducting a public hearing into the proposed fit-out for the Australian Federal Police (AFP) at 45 Commercial Road, Newstead.

The fit-out at the AFP's existing premises on Wharf Road is ten years old and, with its current lease due to expire in early 2017, the AFP have identified more suitable office accommodation in the Brisbane area.

The proposed fit-out works will include meeting and interview rooms, forensic laboratories and workshops, open-plan workstations, conference and training facilities, amenities and appropriate security systems.

The project will also encompass base building works and associated services, including equipment for essential ICT capability to support the AFP's ongoing operational requirements during the relocation.

The project is expected to cost \$25 million (excluding GST).
