

## Garden Island wharf under scrutiny

The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works will hold a public hearing in Sydney on Thursday to examine the Department of Defence's proposed Garden Island (East) Critical Infrastructure Recovery Program.

The project proposes to provide a fully functioning wharf that will provide for both current and future requirements at the north-west end of the Garden Island Defence Precinct in Sydney. The estimated cost of the project is \$213.4 million, excluding GST.
