Subject: Submarine Rotational Force

I am a resident of Safety Bay, a suburb located about 14 km from HMAS Stirling on Garden Island. In the short time allowed to me for comment, I declare myself available for participation in debate and for long-term civic protest, and offer the following statement in relation to published proposals.

I strenuously object to intolerable hazards which the Australian Government proposes to impose on my peaceful neighbourhood environment resulting from the warlike AUKUS treaty. Those hazards include:

IMMIGRATION of large numbers of US military personnel who, as frequently demonstrated internationally, will not be subject to the jurisdiction of local justice institutions;

CULTURAL CONFLICT resulting from placement of a massive bloc of foreign US belligerents and their families (reportedly 700 or more) in our quiet Australian community environment;

HOUSING SCARCITY AND INAFFORDABILITY aggravated by the extreme market demands brought about by the sudden large-scale increase in population;

REDEVELOPMENT CONFLICT contingent on the unreasonable market demands, including necessity for abnormal residential and roadway construction in an environmentally sensitive region;

NUCLEAR WASTE STORAGE which is not conscionable in the midst of an extensive population and the environmental requirements of the adjacent Shoalwater Islands Marine Park;

NUCLEAR WASTE ACCUMULATION FROM FOREIGN SOURCES;

WARLIKE LOCAL PREPARATIONS in absence of genuine consultation and parliamentary debate;

INEVITABLE TARGETING OF GARDEN ISLAND BY ENEMY NUCLEAR WEAPONRY;

GENERAL DISREGARD of the natural rights and interests of locally resident families.
