Question

The other area is, let us say, queries other than value-for-money queries that have been raised within the state systems particularly—because I have not heard any, I must say, in the Catholic and independent systems—for example, schools or communities that got buildings they did not want, had buildings forced on them or had transportables removed only to be replaced by other transportables, as reported to us.

Do you intend to report this to the parliament? Firstly, how are you going to measure it, and, secondly, how can we expect that you will report it?
