

I believe in freedom of choice. It is my choice as a mother and my choice alone what goes into my child's body.

I gave birth to a perfectly healthy baby who was given a 10 out of 10 by the doctor delivering her. My daughter had the Hepatitis B vaccination when only a few hours old. From that moment onwards she screamed, didn't sleep, fed erratically, became covered in a very angry eczema rash and had constant diarrhea.
