**Mr Tregurtha:** Our primary work in that space at the moment is on the national standard and the passage of that, so that's the first step, and that's certainly where the focus of the department is at the moment. As Mr McGregor said, the draft bill is out for public comment, and we hope to introduce it towards the middle of the year.

Ms SWANSON: What was that draft bill called?

**Mr McGregor:** I'll get the exact title for you. It's a framework piece of legislation which will establish the national standard for the environmental risk management of chemicals. It will provide the mechanism through which chemicals of concern can be scheduled and through which risk management measures can be—

## Answer:

The title is the Industrial Chemicals Environmental Management (Register) Bill.
