Signatories to PRRT Open Letter

To the Australian Government

Local governments bear enormous costs from the impact of fossil fuels on our climate, including sea level rise and the aftermath of increasingly frequent and extreme fires, floods, storms and heatwaves.

However, local governments are the least resourced level of government to cope with the increasing costs of addressing climate impacts, such as maintaining infrastructure and services after climate disasters.

Meanwhile, multinational oil and gas corporations exporting gas – a dangerous fossil fuel – from Australia are fuelling climate change but pay none of the costs of the damage their emissions cause.

These companies make windfall profits, while many pay no petroleum resource rent tax (PRRT), receive the gas they export for free, pay little or no company tax, and benefit from taxpayer subsidies.

Increasing the PRRT collected from fossil fuel companies making windfall profits offers an opportunity to redress this balance. Taxing fossil fuel companies more to pay for the climate damage they cause can secure funding for local governments to cope with the impacts of climate change.

We call on the Australian Government to ensure the PRRT changes collect an additional \$10 billion annually to assist Australian local governments with climate impact funding.
