Any preliminary data available for the current quarter on apprentice and trainee commencements, cancellations, withdrawals and completions, including where employment contracts have been terminated or apprentices returned to Group Training Organisations.

Preliminary commencement, completion, suspension and withdrawal numbers for the March quarter data is generally released by the National Centre for Vocational Education Research (NCVER) in August, and for the June quarter generally released in November. Officers will be available at the hearing to provide evidence on preliminary commencement, completion, suspension and withdrawal numbers based on feedback from stakeholders within the sector.
