Inquiry into the effectiveness of Airservices Australia's management of aircraft noise

Thank you for the opportunity to submit comments to the inquiry into the effectiveness of Airservices Australia's management of aircraft noise.

My submission is provided in the context of the living directly under the flight path of Perth Airport. I am subjected to varying degrees of aircraft noise nuisance effects.

I am painfully aware that an airport is nearby and I suffer from the noise made by the aircraft landing and take-off. My house is not noise insulated. I cannot sleep, communicate (both in person or by phone), listen to the radio or TV, as a result of regular noise from constant aircraft landing and take-off.

I am in my senior years and have a need for peace and quiet for my well-being. I am at home all day, seven days a week.

One solution is to reduce the problem by placing flight constraints e.g. a ban on flights during certain hours. If this solution does not work, there should be a monetary compensation to reduce the noise nuisance. I hope that the outcome of the Inquiry will support the case for insulation compensation and double glazing.

I would like to like to the committee to recommend compensation for residents affected by airport noise through a noise amelioration scheme, similar to the successful schemes in Sydney and Adelaide. These schemes included roof insulation, double glazing.
