I would petition the Senate Committee considering the Human Rights and Anti-Discrimination Bill 2012 to consider either abandoning the currently planned legislation or effecting changes to allow

- 1. The onus of proof to be on those bringing the accusations rather than the respondent
- 2. Allowing all parties to have legal advisers at conciliation conferences to ensure justice for all
- 3. Providing exemptions to groups who hold deeply held religious beliefs which have been clearly documented.

Whilst believing that Anti-Discrimination is abhorrent and every Human Being's rights should be upheld, I am concerned that the current legislation being considered does not uphold freedom for all member of our community. Rosamund Elise Riley
