My family and I live on our property approximately 2KM from the proposed Mt Emerald Wind Farm on the Atherton Tablelands, Far North Queensland.

We have grave concerns regarding the noise levels that the proposed 75 wind turbines will create. The issue of health concerns arising because of wind turbines is not new and there are many residents around the world who have been adversely affected by this so called "clean" energy source.
