If the Federal Govt powers to control as per the existing act there will be no real checks and balances on issues relating to the current items in the Federal act.

Areas needing protection including the Great Barrier Reef and the Mary River would be left open to decisions being made by DERM under their new name and in our experience relating to the assessment of a proposed open cut coal mine at Colton Qld. they just do not have the skills or knowledge to competently asses these items and tend to rely totally on the information provided by miners consultants.

As we saw in relation to the Traviston Dam which was approved by DERM and then rejected by the Federal Govt. The Qld Govt are just not fully staffed or equipped to deal with these matters.

The reduction of the Federal Environmental powers of assessment would put many areas if significant importance at risk of haphazard selective decisions which could be motivated by the financial budget needs of the Qld. Govt.
