Antarctica inquiry continues

The [Joint Standing Committee on the National Capital and External Territories](#) will hear from political scientist, Professor Anne-Marie Brady, at the final public hearing for the inquiry into Australia's Antarctic Territory, on February 15 in Canberra.

Committee Chair, [Mr Ben Morton MP](#), said the Committee was looking forward to hearing from Professor Brady on her recent analysis of Chinese activity in eastern Antarctic, including in Australia's Antarctica Territory.

The Committee will also hear evidence on international engagement and other topics related to Australia's Antarctic Program from a number of Australian Government agencies, including the Department of the Environment and Energy, the Department of Defence, the Department of Finance and the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.
