CHAIR: In terms of the reviews that have been done, Professor Gilbert did the Newmarch

report, and I think she also did Dorothy Henderson, didn't she? Dr Murphy: Yes. With Newmarch she was joined by Mr Lilly.

CHAIR: And she's been commissioned to do St Basil's?

Dr Murphy: Yes, St Basil's and Epping Gardens, also in partnership with Mr Lilly.

CHAIR: Was that by limited tender? I think there's only one contractor. On AusTender it's difficult to track what's happened with that.

Dr Murphy: They were direct procurements. It's very hard to find the right expertise. And given that their expertise grew from the New South Wales outbreaks we saw, we needed to—particularly in the context of St Basil's, the families were very, very keen to feed back to an independent reviewer within days the issues that occurred there. So, we arranged for Mr Lilly to have a long Zoom briefing, for some hours, with the families. We had to initiate his contract fairly quickly, because it's really important for the families to be able to express their concerns to an independent person.

CHAIR: Are those contracts on AusTender?
Ms Laffan: I'm not sure. I'd have to check that.
