The reasons for the Referral for the Committee to consider are absolutely brilliant and very long overdue. I applaud the Committee members for bringing about an inquiry on this particular topic. There were similar referendums run here in Victoria against the toxic dumping plans for Nowingi, and the Channel Deepening Project in Port Philip Bay which grew in size to include a toxic waste dump. The State of Victoria were about to limit the powers of the Supreme Court with the holus bolus introduction of The Channel Deepening Facilitation Bill, which thankfully was squelched due to public outcry.
