Cancellation of public hearing

As part of its inquiry into investigations into a possible cancer cluster on the Bellarine Peninsula in Victoria, the Senate Community Affairs References Committee had planned a public hearing on 10 February 2021 on the Bellarine Peninsula.

Due to the evolving COVID-19 concerns in Victoria this week, the committee has made the decision to cancel this public hearing, which was to be held at Barwon Heads.

The committee's chair, Senator Rachel Siewert said:

'This cancellation is unfortunate, but the committee's priority has to be safety for all concerned. The committee remains determined to visit the Bellarine Peninsula to hear directly from people in the community about their concerns.'

Another public hearing will be scheduled at a later date.

- (c) the evidence, approach and outcomes concerning the Victorian Chief Health Officer's investigation of cancer rates on the Bellarine Peninsula; and
- (d) any other related matter.
