Witnesses will appear before the Joint Standing Committee on Electoral Matters on Friday to answer questions regarding authorisation of electoral communication to voters. Authorisation ensures electors are informed about the source of electoral advertising and comment.

"As part of a broad ranging inquiry into the conduct of the 2016 Federal Election the Committee will also be examining a range of issues, including differences in the authorisations required for electoral advertising in different formats and for different players," said Committee Chair Senator Linda Reynolds.
