To whom it may concern,

The majority of the Australian voting public has not given the Greens Party or the Australian Labpr Party a democratic mandate on this proposed Bill.

Unmandated lobbying on social engineering:

1. appears to be unconstitutional and a perversion and alienation of the rights of the majority;
2. is a form of unsubstantiated dictatorial impositions on a hapless public majority unable to consolidate a majority expression between elections;
