Question:

Mr GORMAN: It takes us to some of the questions that we've received on notice. Senator O'Neill asked some questions around pension payments of sorts from Deloitte. I think the answer to the question on notice we received noted that you had three cases where individuals under contract in 2018 or 2019 received pensions from one of the big four, and they were members of ASIC's own audit committee up until November 2019. I think it would also be useful to know any other sources of income being received by any member of the audit committee. I think that would be a very useful piece of information that I will ask you to also take on notice. You might be able to provide some of this by the end of today.
