Water use efficiency inquiry hearings in Toowoomba and Narrabri

5 and 6 April 2017

The House Agriculture and Water Resources committee will hold public hearings in Toowoomba on Wednesday 5 April and Narrabri on Thursday 6 April for its inquiry into water use efficiency in Australian agriculture.

The Toowoomba hearing on 5 April will feature Cotton Australia, Growcom, and irrigator groups from the Central Downs and the Border Rivers regions.

In Narrabri on 6 April the committee will hear from the CSIRO and NSW Department of Primary Industries, Associate Professor Guy Roth, and irrigator groups from the Namoi Valley and Gwydir Valley.
