Recommendation 1
The Committee recommends that the House of Representatives resolve, pursuant to Section 18(7) of the <i>Public Works Committee Act 1969</i> , that it is expedient to carry out the following proposed works: Australian Securities & Investments Commission Proposed Fit Out of New Leased Premises at 100 Market Street, Sydney.
Australian Government Response

Recommendation 2
The Committee recommends that the Auditor-General considers conducting an audit into the process undertaken by the Australian Taxation Office in identifying and selecting 152 Wharf Street as the preferred site for the works.
