Question:

In relation to the Victorian Aged Care Response Centre (VACRC):

- a. What is the VACRC's total budget?
- b. What costs are covered by the Commonwealth?
- c. How much has been spent to date?

Answer:

- A. The Victorian Aged Care Response Centre budget is \$9.1 million (2020-21 Budget: Health and Home Affairs portfolios). In-kind support is provided by the Victorian Department of Health and Human Services, and other Australian Government agencies, including the Australian Defence Force.
- B. Costs covered by the Commonwealth, through this funding, includes clinical leads, additional case management capacity, and logistical support.
- C. As at 3 November 2020, \$4.5 million has been committed with \$1.8 million (ex. GST) spent.
