Commonwealth Rent Assistance is accessible by eligible Family Tax Benefit recipients as well as those on primary payments.

^{**} Number of Rent Assistance recipients are counted by income units. An income unit comprises a single person (with or without dependent children) or a couple (with or without dependent children). Single social security recipients living together in the same household are regarded as separate income units.

As noted above, as Rent Assistance recipient data only started being collected weekly from 20 March 2020, there is no comparative weekly data for 2019 as data was collected quarterly in 2019.

As at 29 March 2019, 1,294,433 income units received Rent Assistance.

Data is not available for the number of Rent Assistance applications on hand each week because Rent Assistance is not claimed separately. Eligibility for Rent Assistance is assessed when a person claims an eligible primary income support payment such as JobSeeker Payment.
