I strongly approve of the "Health Insurance Amendment (Medicare Funding for certain types of abortions) Bill 2013 put forward by Senator Madigan.

- 1. It is totally unacceptable to me that Medicare Funding can be used for the purpose of gender-selection abortion.
- 2. I am deeply disturbed by the prevalence of gender-selection with preference for a male child amongst some ethnic groups in Australia and the use of Medicare-funded abortions to terminate female children.
- 3. I strongly disapprove of Medicare-funded gender-selection abortions to achieve so-called 'Family Balancing'. It is unacceptable to me that any child is aborted especially on the basis of gender. Every baby has the right to life.
- 4. I support the united Nations efforts to end discriminatory practices of gender-selection, through implementing disincentives for gender-selection abortions. The Australian Government can support this campaign by refusing to fund gender-selection abortions any longer.

I ask the Australian Parliament to pass this Bill unconditionally. To lead the way in the world in upholding the right of every child to be protected from gender-selected abortion, especially female babies.
