With regard to the upcoming debate on the governance of Government Superanuation Schemes, I would like to make my thoughts known.

As a serving member I am concerned that with the change to the new scheme will disadvantage me. Whilst I have to put some faith that my investments themselves will not suffer from the proposed merger, I am very concerned that Defence is not being adequately represented on the 10 man committee. I believe that defence should have the same number of representatives as the unions choose with the balance made up from the Finance Minister. This to me would mean 3 members each from defence and the unions with the balancing 4 from the Finance Minister.

This will allow defence an equal say as the union movement when decisions are made and will ensure defences views are not swamped by the unions.
