



Campaigning inquiry commences public hearings in Canberra

The Joint Standing Committee on Electoral Matters will commence public hearings as part of its inquiry into campaigning at polling places on Thursday (16 July) at Parliament House.

The Committee will hear evidence from the Australian Electoral Commission in relation to campaign activities in the vicinity of polling places, with particular reference to:

- distribution of how-to-vote cards
- campaigning by organisations other than political parties
- allegations in relation to the conduct of, and material disseminated by, campaigners at state and federal elections that are intended or likely to mislead or intimidate electors
