Public hearing into proposed Helicopter Aircrew Training System (HATS) Facilities Project

The Public Works Committee is conducting a public hearing into the proposed new Helicopter Aircrew Training System (HATS) Facilities Project for HMAS *Albatross*, NSW and Jervis Bay Airfield.

The Government is acquiring new naval combat and battlefield helicopters which are advanced, new generation helicopters. The Department of Defence has told the Committee that an upgrade to the introductory helicopter training system is required to ensure aircrew are adequately trained to operate them.

The project will use commercial-off-the-shelf and military-off—the-shelf technologies to deliver a complete training system which will be supported by hangar, maintenance, training, administration, storage and warehousing facilities.

The proposed new HATS capability will be a significant component of Australian Defence Force aircrew training in which trainees develop aviation competencies and experience to make them fully-mission-capable frontline helicopter aircrew.

Works are expected to begin in mid-2015, with completion of all works expected by mid-2017. The estimated cost of the project is \$157.1 million, excluding GST.
