We oppose the uncontrolled expansion of windfarms particularly in the western district of Victoria for the following reasons.

- 1. There is now increasing evidence of effects on the health of those living within and up to five km from wind turbines as evidenced by reports from the Waubra district.
- 2. Homes and properties have become difficult to sell in such areas. Land valuations are showing a drop of up to 30% in places that have planned windfarms.
- 3. Planning laws do not cater in any way for residents living within the boundaries of windfarms or in the surrounding area.
- 4. Stockyard Hill is an area of wetlands and natural bird habitat. There should not be any wind turbines in the area.
- 5. Research shows very small savings in greenhouse gases at a large cost to the taxpayer in subsides and to the public in the cost of electricity.
- 6. The noise factor has not been researched regarding the 3 megawat turbines now being used.
- 7. The 1998 acoustic standards are plainly well out of date.
- 8. There should be a thorough and independent inquiry into all aspects of windfarms taking into consideration all of the above.
