

## RECOMMENATIONS FOR PARLIMENT OF AUSTRALIA. (SENATE)

Dear Senate Committee,

We are an organisation that sees these sorts of wrongs on a daily basis. After spending a lot of time with victims that have received such payment as these outlined in this enquiry. Nearly all the victims are wanting the government to take only some of the reasonability but not all. For past mistakes and the perpetrator to be fully accountable for their actions. We are also finding the same to be with the (G2.) Generation 2 of Forgotten and stolen generation.

Theses G2 I refer to have not as yet to take made claims of compensation as you may be aware that there are many more claims to come.

I go on to make the following recommendations as follows:

### ACCOUTABILTY

I am requesting the following recommendations as stated. I will require a detailed response to each matter in writing. To

RECOMMENATION 1. Statutes of limitations be changed or amended under the child protection act. With no time limit. This would only apply from the date this has been passed. This in turn will hold the perpetrator accountable for their actions. Thinking before acting. Putting the right people in the job. Relieving the system (State government.)Of further litigations. Freeing up funds.

RECOMMENATION 2. Those that are found to be making false and miss leading allegation to be held accountable were by a fine or jail time is imposed. This will free up funds making funds more available to be spent else were. This will also free up time for cwo's. This will also weed out the time wasters or people that just want to be malice.

RECOMMENATION 3. A program put in place for young people in the system. This program will reflect or focus on future goals and what little happiness they have experienced.

RECOMMENATION 4. Victims or passed yigss to take part in new recruits and tell their stories. This will create a better understanding of these situations and can be more understood by the recruit for people that have not had these experiences. They are able to learn from past mistakes. This includes anyone who works in the department. (Foster Parents, Group Home, Detention Centres e.c.t

RECOMMENATION 5. A day or week of recognition for yigss past and present. Incorporing the following matters:

1. Recruitment of staff and carers (foster/temp e.c.t)
2. Child abuse awareness.
3. Child abuse is every body's business.
4. Encourage victims to come forward.
5. Recognition for past mistakes.

RECOMMENATION 7.

Put in place a program of living skill. This will include how to cook, do washing, shopping, budgeting and general day to day living skill that will be required for basic day to day living in the real world. In turn this will make the transition to independent living smoother.
