Income Management (IM) exclusions as at 14 June 2024

Data caveats:

- IM exclusions commenced in 2012 with none being recorded until 2013.
- 'Total exclusions' include only those that have been approved.
- **Not practical exclusions** refer to a vulnerable young person on IM that places their mental, physical or emotional wellbeing at risk.
- **Detrimental exclusions** refer to a vulnerable young person that had less than 25% of their basic rate of payment for at least 4 of the last 6 fortnights.

- Data includes all customers who have been granted an exclusion and ended participation on the enhanced IM program.
- Customers that were granted an exclusion from the Vulnerable Youth measure but qualified under another measure have not been included.
- Total Exclusions' includes only those that have been approved.
- **Not practical exclusions** refer to a vulnerable young person on enhanced IM that places their mental, physical or emotional wellbeing at risk.
- **Detrimental exclusions** refer to a vulnerable young person that had less than 25% of their basic rate of payment for at least 4 of the last 6 fortnights.
- Numbers less than 5 are suppressed as <5 in line with the department's Data Confidentiality Policy. In some instances, figures may not be provided if the actual number can be derived such as subtracting from a total. As a result, the sum of each row in a column may not add to equal the column totals.
