Dear Madam and the Members of the Committee.

I am not well versed on the disposal issues of Radioactive materials,
HOWEVER: -

- 1) The people owning the land where such material is to be placed need to be consulted AND listened to.
- 2) Assuming the "waste" needs to be SECURED/SAFE----then there is an absolute necessity to have GOOD, RELIABLE, ONGOING, APPROPRIATE PERSONNEL CONTINUALLY PRESENT to provide such SECURITY.
- 3) Australia cannot afford to have such people spread around the country-----This seems to demand that the "waste" may be better (more reliably and economically) "secured" close to the source of production and useage----Meaning only ONE security issue not several.
