# Call for submissions

Issue date: 24th September 2024

The Senate has established a Select Committee on Energy Planning and Regulation in Australia to inquire into the institutional structures, governance, regulation, functions, and operation of the Australian energy market.

Committee Chair, Senator Van, indicated that the committee wants to hear from a diverse range of stakeholders with experience and expertise in energy transition policy, planning and regulation.

'Emissions from electricity generation make up nearly one-third of Australia's overall emissions, therefore getting the transition to a zero emmissions energy system is of utmost importance,' said Senator Van. 'However, given the current structures there has been insufficient public accountability of the decisions made in guiding this.'

This Inquiry aims to bring transparency and accountability to decisions made in system planning to ensure they satisfy the National Electricity Objectives equally.
