Questions taken on notice: Inquiry into Commonwealth Bilateral Air Service Agreements

Chair

- 1. Could you provide us with when [your clients] found out about the Qatar Airways decision on the public record?
- 1.1 Although at the time that I gave my answer to the Chair I believed, based on the date of Minister King's letter, that our clients had found out about the Minister's decision on 10 July 2023, I have since been informed that although the letter was dated 10 July 2023, our clients actually received the letter by email on 17 July 2023.
- 2. What is the government doing to assist your clients?
- 2.1 I am aware from media reports on 6 September 2023 and a statement issued by the Qatar Foreign Ministry that a telephone call had occurred on 4 September 2023 between the Foreign Minister and the Prime Minister of Qatar, in which the incident was discussed.
- 2.2 It is entirely possible that other representations have been and are being made through diplomatic channels, which are not on the public record. However, I do not know and do not expect to be told by the government what happens via diplomatic channels.

- 3. On what date did [one of your clients and a representative of your firm] meet with the Foreign Minister?
- 3.1 One of our clients and Damian Sturzaker of Marque Lawyers met with the Foreign Minister on Tuesday, 5 September 2023.
- 4. Was that the first engagement you or your clients had had with officials from the Department of Foreign Affairs?
- 4.1 On 31 August 2023, our firm wrote a letter to the Foreign Minister asking for a meeting between the Minister and one of our clients. The meeting took place on 5 September 2023.
- 4.2 Prior to that, on 19 August 2022 our firm wrote to

requesting a copy of the report



into the incident, that was provided to the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade by the State of Qatar, referred to in a joint statement issued on 31 October 2020. On 31 August 2022, we received a letter in respect of this request, which was signed by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.

5. Was the Foreign Minister able to provide information to your clients about what advocacy the new government had undertaken on their behalf?

- 5.1 The Foreign Minister indicated that representations were being made to the Qatar government. I am aware from media reports on 6 September 2023 and a statement issued by the Qatar Foreign Ministry that a telephone call had occurred on 4 September 2023 between the Foreign Minister and the Prime Minister of Qatar, in which the incident was discussed.
- 5.2 It is entirely possible that other representations have been and are being made through diplomatic channels, which are not on the public record. However, I do not know and do not expect to be told by the Foreign Minister what happens via diplomatic channels.
