Senator Barnett requested an update to an answer provided in response to a question on notice asked on 23 February 2009. Senator Barnett's question was:

Provide the cost to the Department, for both the previous and current financial year, associated with the implementation of the new personal property and securities legislative regime. Provide a breakdown of these costs and a list of consultancies, reviews and other outsourcing arrangements that have been undertaken in the 2007-08 and the 2008-09 financial years.

The answer to Senator Barnett's question (to 30 June 2009) is as follows:
