Inquiry into the Australian film and literature classification scheme

On 7 April 2011 the Arts Law Centre of Australia appeared before the Senate Inquiry into the Australian film and literature classification scheme. In that session we took a question on notice from Senator Barnett regarding photographs in a recent art exhibition by the artist Bill Henson.
