Mr Gianniotis: If you asked me today, yes. It is always a moving beast. I got the numbers this inquiry and, yes, if I could put on another five fabricators I'd do it now.

CHAIR: How many Australian jobs hang off the work of those five fabricators?

Mr Gianniotis: I would have to do the numbers—and I probably need my account guess—to please don't quote me—but I would say that it would equate to about \$5 million to turnover.

CHAIR: Do you want to come back to us later in the week with the numbers? Understanding the way in which skilled migration can help create Australian jobs too.

Mr Gianniotis: Sure.

For every fabricator, we are currently employing 1.1 x labourers and 0.65 x supervisors. So off 5 x skilled fabricators, possibly another 8.75 Australian jobs could be employed off the back of.
