I am unable to comprehend your reasoning for what constitutes a remote region.

I would like to know how you came to decide that Boston 5607, Tiatukia 5607, North Shields 5607 are a remote region. When its boundaries along or near Port Lincoln.

All people living in these areas and participation in the CDP must travel to Port Lincoln for their appointments and the Work for the dole compulsory 25 hours 52 weeks a year.

How can these areas be remote but residence are required to travel to Port Lincoln to participate in CPD and attend appointments with Complete Personnel.

I believe that people on benefits should participate in their community but your programme is unfair. The Community Development Programme is making vulnerable people more destitute and keeping the greens of golf courses pristine as they are being maintained by people who have no choice. I am uncertain what skills I am meant to be gaining by maintaining a golf course?

The CPD has made furthering my education and gaining greater qualifications an unobtainable goal. I have never been unemployed until two months ago when I could no longer afford my study subjects while working causally.

I hope the next time you make changes that you consider not everyone on welfare is a dole bludger. Sometime life just happens and people need a helpful hand to assist them back up not a slap in the face to keep them down.
