Senate Committee invites members of the Hobart community to share their views

The Senate Select Committee on the Cost of Living has announced a public hearing in Hobart, to be held on Monday, 10 July 2023 at Rydges Hobart, 393 Argyle St, North Hobart.

The committee invites members of the Hobart community to share their views about, and lived experience of, the cost of living pressures they face, during a community forum session from 3.45pm to 4.30pm.

The Senate established the Select Committee on the Cost of Living to inquire into and report on:

- a. the cost of living pressures facing Australians;
- b. the Government's fiscal policy response to the cost of living;
- c. ways to ease cost of living pressures through the tax and transfer system;
- d. measures to ease the cost of living through the provision of Government services; and
- e. any other related matter.

Members of the community who address the committee will be asked to give a statement of **no longer than five minutes**. Senators may ask follow-up questions after each statement has been given.

Individuals or community could representatives interested in addressing the committee are encouraged to register in advance by completing the form available at: https://www.aph.gov.au/Parliamentary_Business/Committees/Senate/Cost_of_Living/costofliving/Community_Forum_Registration. They may also register on the day by attending in person and making themselves known to the secretariat before the session starts.

Despite the committee's best endeavours, it may be that not everyone who wishes to address the committee may be able to do so in the time available to the committee.

Members of the community that do not have an opportunity to directly address the committee are still encouraged to share their views and experiences via the committee's cost of living survey on its webpage. The survey takes only five minutes to complete and allows Australians to make formal submissions to the inquiry in a simple and easy to navigate way.

The hearings will also provide the committee with the opportunity to hear from Tasmanian community groups, industry and government.
