Senator SIEWERT:Can you tell me the total number?

Ms Laffan: In terms of-

Mr Lye: I think it's 36. No, sorry, it's 36 in Victoria.

Ms Laffan: As at 25 September, Mable has supplied 130 contractors and filled 2,644 shifts. Senator SIEWERT: Is that across New South Wales and Victoria?

Ms Laffan: That figure is nationally.

Mr Lye: I think that we'll get you the exact number, because Ms Laffan's figures may be more up-to-date than mine, but I know they've provided services in residential aged care in Victoria, New South Wales and Tasmania.

Senator SIEWERT: And the Commonwealth government has made that decision to take them on? It was a Commonwealth decision?

Mr Lye: What we could do is provide you the seven or eight contract organisations that we've got a relationship with who are supplying workforce to outbreak sites. I will name some of them: Aspen, Healthcare Australia, HealthX, Mable, RCSA, Torrens. There are a range of people that we have engaged, and Mable is one of those.

Senator SIEWERT: Could you provide the list and how much each of these contracts is worth—how much the original contract was, whether they've been extended, when they're contracted to and the services they have provided?

Ms Laffan: Yes, we can do that.

Mr Lye: And we can provide the total staff provided, the shifts filled and probably even what type of staff they're providing. We've got all of that detail.
