At moment, I am holding a temporary resident visa. Also I am now working on IELTS to meet the requirement of becoming a permanent resident.

I came to Australia 3 years ago. During these 3 years, I successfully finished my studies and obtained my master degree. Where at beginning I was thinking of I may be able to do some contributions to Australia. However, during these 3 years, the immigration policy is changing every year, higher English standard, professional year, etc. I can understand Australia government wants more high value immigration rather than let everybody in. But such a frequent changing policy situation which I do believe is absolutely unfair to new immigrations. During these 3 studying years, I bought cars. I worked part-time, I payed thousands dollars tax per year, I work very hard, now I am working sometime more than 55 hours a week. No matter the contribution is big or small, I do think myself do a lot contribution to Australia economy.

I am a well educated person love to live in Australia, especially the lifestyle, friendly people and beautiful views. However, I am so confusing about how can I do more to stay here? According the policy 2 years ago, I already met the PR requirement. According the policy 1 year ago, once I meet the IELTS requirement, I definitely will become a PR. NOW, with this VISA CAPPING PROGRAM, I have no idea what I need to do more!!
