Inquiry into the expansion of ACLEI's jurisdiction and the corruption vulnerabilities associated with law enforcement agencies' contracted services

It has come to my attention that there was an error in the presentation of the data in Table 1 of ACLEI's submission (p.10). One of the rows in that table was inadvertently removed in the editing of the submission, with the result that while the total number of matters received reported in the table was correct, some of the underlying data was missing or in the incorrect row.

The correct section of the table is as follows:
