Oil and gas exploration and production in the Beetaloo Basin

Thank you for your letter dated 15 October 2021.

In considering your response, the committee notes that some of its questions were not fully answered. To be clear, the committee requests that you address each of the following questions separately and in turn:

- 1. Can you please advise the committee whether Empire Energy or any of its staff verbally communicated with you or your office in relation to the eligibility criteria and application process for the grant program prior to 18 March 2021?
- 2. Did you or your office receive a copy, have knowledge of or participate in an email exchange between the Minister for Energy and Emissions Reduction and Empire Energy dated 14 January 2021 (FOI Disclosure Log 21-013-68011m, p. 6, <u>attached</u>)?

In this respect, the committee draws your attention to Senate Procedural Resolution 51 which clearly indicates that the fact that a freedom of information request for information has been or could be refused under the FOI Act is not a legitimate basis for declining to provide documents or answer questions.

- 3. Can you advise whether you or your office discussed with Minister Taylor or his office communications between them and Empire in relation to the grant program? Please provide the committee with a copy of any written documentation evidencing that discussion?
- 4. FOI Disclosure Document 68003 (<u>attached</u>) appears to show correspondence to or from Empire Energy on 6 January 2021. Please provide a copy of this unredacted email, again noting Procedural Resolution 51.
- 5. Have you and Minister Taylor, or your respective offices, discussed applications and applicants for funding under the grant program?

6. In relation to the identification of requested documents, please see Order for Production of Documents No. 1209 at p. 114, which refers to Attachment A (BCDP Funding Matrix) and Attachment B (Disclosure of Interests), and at p. 115, which refers to 'all Attachments [that] form the minutes of the Beetaloo Cooperative Drilling Program Committee meeting held on 24 May 2021'.

The committee would appreciate your response to its questions by 3 November 2021.

SENATE ORDER FOR THE PROUDCTION OF DOCUMENTS NO 1262

In relation to your request for additional documents to those provided in OPD1209, you have identified recently which documents you now seek.

I attach the Beetaloo Cooperative Drilling Program Funding Matrix which was noted as Attachment A in the documents previously supplied to you.

I also attach the Disclosure of Interests which was noted as Attachment B in the documents previously supplied to you.

Please note that I am making a claim of Public Interest Immunity over the redacted materials in the documents referred to as 'Attachment A Beetaloo – Funding Tracking Sheet – Scoring Matrix' and 'Attachment B DOI – List of Application – Beetaloo May 2021' on the grounds that release of this information has the potential to damage the commercial interests of applicants to the Beetaloo Cooperative Drilling Program and their suppliers. This information is not publicly available and relates to the commercial intentions of the affected parties. It has the potential to impact on the ability of affected parties to effectively plan activities and negotiate fairly with suppliers.

In relation to other items, I would like to re-state as I have done on numerous occasions that neither I, nor my office, had meetings with Empire Energy.

I confirm that neither I nor my office, has held meetings with Minister Taylor or his office, to discuss the Beetaloo Cooperative Drilling Program.

I re-state that I as Minister for Resources and Water am the only decision maker in relation to approving grant agreements under the Beetaloo Cooperative Drilling Program, after taking into account the application assessment made by an assessment committee of experts.


