Public hearing on Department of Immigration and Border Protection head office fit out

The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works will hold a public hearing in Canberra on Monday to examine the proposed the fit out of both newly leased and existing office space for the Department of Immigration and Border Protection.

The proposal is intended to consolidate the Department's current office space in the Canberra area into two locations at the Belconnen Town Centre and the Airport Business Park.

The fit-out of the new accommodation is anticipated to begin in August 2017, and is expected to be completed by February 2021. The proposed works are estimated to cost approximately \$257.3 million (excluding GST).
