TREASURY LAWS AMENDMENT (PERSONAL INCOME TAX PLAN) BILL 2018

ASBFEO welcomes the tax relief provided via proposed low and middle income tax reduction the Treasury laws Amendment Bill 2018 (Personal Income tax plan). This will encompass the nearly one million small businesses that are not incorporated.

The changes to the tax brackets out to 2024-25 will free up cash for unincorporated small business to invest in the growth of their business.
