I am a casual employee, working as a stevedore, currently earning around 46 per hour.

I have not been working for the last 18 months as i had a stroke and i hope to get back to work to pay off my house before the bank want it back.

If penalty rates were abolished...our employer worked out a fair rate because we work 12 hour shifts which can be on weekends or weekdays but if penalty rates were abolished they can scrap this hourly rate. That means that most people wouldnt bother to work there as the hourly rate wouldnt be worth it which would stop yet another valuable form of employment in this area which is badly in need of any work at the moment.
