

The action officers have been super quick! I set out below the answers to the questions taken on notice at the hearing.

- ‘How large is the [CSIRO] site [in Campbell]?’ – (page 7, from the Committee Chair, Mr Morton)
  - The CSIRO site in Campbell (Blocks 4 & 5 Section 38 Campbell) is 40107m<sup>2</sup>, or just over four hectares, in size.
- ‘Could you indicate the age of the [CSIRO] building [in Campbell]?’ – (page 8, from the Chair)
  - There are three buildings on the CSIRO Campbell site. The two buildings closest to Limestone Avenue, a five storey office building and adjoining single level lobby and conference centre, were constructed in 1970. The third building, a two storey office building, was constructed in the early 1980s.
- Could we get clarity around who is actually responsible for [the safety and security of the CSIRO building in Campbell]?’ – (page 8, from Ms Brodtmann)
  - The lessee, currently Doma Group, is responsible for safety and security of the buildings on the CSIRO Campbell site.
- ‘... going back to the 2017-18 budget for the modernisation and the upgrades of the systems – how much did you actually receive? ... Have you got a breakdown of what each of these programs are getting ...?’ (page 8, from Ms Brodtmann)
  - The total figure is around that stated at the hearing; the specific figures have not been published due to commercial sensitivities.
- ‘How many submissions did you receive [on the Forrest and Deakin plan]?’ (page 9, from Ms Brodtmann)
  - Some 37 submissions from 36 different parties were received in response to the Deakin/Forrest Residential Precinct Issues Paper.
